- Updating consolidation and elimination entries in connection with the monthly close.
- Reviewing of Controller reporting from the subsidiaries to ensure Controller forms are complete and accurate.
- Assisting the Director, Financial Reporting and Compliance with preparation of the Monthly reporting package to NMC including financial results, financial statistics, cash flow information, etc.
- Assisting with requirements for bank reporting related to the Company's term loan which requires quarterly unaudited financial statements, management's discussion and analysis, covenant calculations, audited financial statements and projections.
- Assisting with year-end audit including coordination of requests from the subsidiaries and by Deloitte to ensure a smooth-running audit
- Preparing and or assisting with tax compliance requests as necessary
- Assisting with valuations for acquired companies
